With presenter - Catherine M. Vogelweid, DVM PhD

Catherine Vogelweid received her DVM degree from the University of Missouri College of Veterinary Medicine in 1980. She completed a residency in Laboratory Animal Medicine & a PhD degree in Pathology at the University of Missouri, and became an ACLAM Diplomate in 1991. Between 2004-2019, she was employed as a teaching professor at the College of Veterinary Medicine at the University of Missouri. Here she added & taught new courses in Animal Disaster Planning & Response in both the veterinary and undergraduate curriculums. In 2015, she co-founded a Large Animal Technical Rescue Team, which was a collaborative effort between DVMs within the College of Veterinary Medicine and first-responders with the Boone County Fire Protection District. Her interest in barn fire safety education was “sparked” by her work with fire fighters. Doctor Vogelweid has been a member of the Missouri Volunteer Veterinary Corps since 2004, and serves as its current Director. At the local level, she has been a member of the Boone County Community Emergency Response Team since 2018. Dr. Vogelweid is passionate about the importance of pre-disaster planning and education. Her work with first-responders and professional planners has shaped her views about how to deliver effective protection for our beloved horses, and this is information that she would love to share with equine enthusiasts.
